


As we passed through West Yellowstone, the Mountain Man Rendezvous was underway. We went directly to Rumbaugh Creek to check possibilities.













Hank led the search up and down Rumbaugh Creek.

We retrieved water from Rumbaugh Creek again and made sure it was secure. We had oversight as we searched.










